NYCRR 118.1, RESPONDENTS.**

**ATTORNEY GRIEVANCE COMMITTEES FOR THE FOURTH JUDICIAL
DEPARTMENT, PETITIONER.**

Petitioner having moved for an order suspending the respondent attorneys named on the attached list for their failure to comply with attorney registration requirements in violation of Judiciary Law § 468-a and 22 NYCRR 118.1, and this Court, by order entered December 27, 2019, having directed respondents to show cause in writing on or before March 27, 2020, why an order should not be entered suspending them from the practice of law for their failure to comply with attorney registration requirements, and the Court having subsequently extended the deadline for written responses to the show cause order to August 1, 2020, and the respondents named on the attached list having either failed to respond to the order of this Court or failed to show cause why they should not be suspended,

NOW, upon reading and filing the order of this Court, entered December 27, 2019, together with proof of service thereof, the written responses of respondents, if any, the attorney registration records maintained by the Office of Court Administration pertaining to the respondents, and due deliberation having been had thereon,

This Court finds that respondents named on the attached list are guilty of professional misconduct, and

It is hereby **ORDERED** that the motion of petitioner is granted and the respondents named on the attached list are suspended from the practice of law, effective immediately and until further order of this Court, and

It is further **ORDERED** that, respondents are commanded for the period of the suspension to desist and refrain from the practice of law in any form, either as principals or agents, clerks or employees of another, and are hereby forbidden to appear as attorneys or counselors at law before any court, judge, justice, board, commission or other public authority, or to give to another an opinion as to the law or its application, or any advice with relation thereto, and

It is further **ORDERED** that respondents shall comply with rule 1020.9 of the Rules of the Appellate Division, Fourth Department (22 NYCRR) and rule 1240.15 of the Rules of the Appellate Division, All Departments (22 NYCRR) governing the conduct of suspended attorneys, and

It is further **ORDERED** that petitioner shall serve the respondents with this order by: mailing a certified copy of the order to each of the respondents at the address provided to the Office of Court Administration by the respondents; publishing a certified copy of the order and the attached list in the New York Law Journal once each week for four consecutive weeks, commencing with the week of November 2, 2020, and ending with the week of November 23, 2020; and posting a certified copy of this order and the attached list on the website maintained by this Court for at least thirty (30) days.

MATTER OF ATTORNEYS IN VIOLATION OF JUDICIARY LAW § 468-a AND 22 NYCRR 118.1, RESPONDENTS. ATTORNEY GRIEVANCE COMMITTEES FOR THE FOURTH JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT, PETITIONER. -- Order of suspension entered. Per Curiam Opinion: In December 2019, the Grievance Committees applied to this Court for an order directing the respondents named on the attached list to show cause why they should not be suspended from the practice of law on the grounds that they violated Judiciary Law § 468-a and 22 NYCRR 118.1 by failing to comply with attorney registration requirements, and that they failed to respond to numerous written inquiries from the Office of Court Administration and the Grievance Committees concerning their delinquency. By order entered December 27, 2019, this Court directed respondents to show cause in writing on or before March 27, 2020, why they should not be suspended for failing to comply with attorney registration requirements. This Court subsequently extended that deadline to August 1, 2020. Respondents either failed to respond in any fashion to the show cause order or otherwise failed to show cause why they should not be suspended.

The failure to comply with attorney registration requirements violates Judiciary Law § 468-a and 22 NYCRR 118.1 and constitutes conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice warranting the imposition of discipline (see *Matter of Attorneys in Violation of Judiciary Law § 468-a*, 54 AD3d 9, 10 [4th Dept 2008]). Accordingly, we conclude that the respondents named on the attached list should be suspended, effective immediately and until further order of this Court.
